

CROWN PREP (WITH RCT) (order of procedure)

- Before Patient Arrives (Ideally the day before the patient is scheduled not always possible)
- Enter patient data into scanner.
- Check Previous notes to see if the reason for Crown is a replacement. IF IT IS A REPLACEMENT WRITE DOWN THE DATE (OR AGE) OF PREVIOUS CROWN.
- Take PA (if endo tooth)
- Take Blood Pressure
- Start patients notes in their chart while taking BP.
- Take shade (vita Classic Guide unless told otherwise) Have patient confirm and approve shade. (Write this in notes with shade in last step!)
- Enter BP
- Image / Scan
- Place topical
- Take preliminary impression for temp
- Let the doctor know patient is ready and has topical placed
- Place Isolite
- The doctor will prep the tooth for restoration. Leaves for hygiene check.
- Pack cord
- Image / Scan (final prep)
- Make Temporary
- Explain post-op instructions to patient
- Take patient to front counter to check out and schedule next visit. REMEMBER THE PASS OFF!
- Send patients case to lab.
- Enter patients case in Lab Manager.
- Make sure notes are finished!
- Turn around room.

Remember our Hourly goal is \$1,200. That means every MINUTE we run behind costs us \$20, Every Minute ahead MAKES us \$20. Be thoughtful and efficient in everything that you do but always remember, the customer satisfaction is our highest priority.
